

"BELLMAN" WALKING TOUR WITH STURE IN STOCKHOLM OLD TOWN



May I introduce to you the very famous and internationally acclaimed 18th century Swedish poet Carl Michael Bellman (1740 – 1795), his origin and extraordinary life in and around Stockholm, his masterpieces, and the poverty stricken street characters from his songs collection "Fredman's Epistles". Come along on a walking minstrel tour through the narrow alleys of Stockholm Old Town ("Gamla Stan"). Experience some Stockholm history and listen to Bellman's time typical songs at the locations where the stories take place. Meet Fredman, Ulla Winblad, Movitz, Fader Berg, and Mollberg as they go about their burlesque lives, with ups and downs.

We start out from the Evert Taube Statue on "Järntorget" in Stockholm Old Town. July – Sep 2024: Tuesdays och Thursdays at 6:00 pm from 9 July to 19 September.
